We are excited to have this opportunity to announce our 1st annual Historic Wallace Blues Festival on Saturday, July 14th, 2012, on Cedar Street between 6th and 7th Streets in downtown Wallace, Idaho. The music line up on the main stage will begin at 11:30 AM and last until about 10:30 PM. Our requirements and general information for vendors at this event are detailed below.

PAYMENT TERMS: Vendors are required to pay by MONEY ORDER or CASHIER CHECK only. Vendors must return the enclosed application and PAYMENT IN FULL no later than June 1st. Spaces are very limited for this event; first come, first serve.

RENTAL FEES: Wallace Blues Festival is offering single non-electrical 10' x 20' spaces for \$100. Single with electrical hook up 10' x 20' for \$125. If you need to double your space, double our price. A single space includes two (2) complementary wristbands for workers. Half price wristbands limited to two (2) additional workers. All workers are required to wear a wristband. Half price tickets must be purchased no later than June 1st. After that date, tickets will be \$25 at the gate on the day of the event.

REFUNDS: This is a RAIN OR SHINE EVENT, so there will be no refunds because of any man made or natural act beyond the control of the Historic Wallace Blues Festival.

SET UP TIMES: Gates will open at 11 AM. Main stage music starts at 11:30 AM. Vendors should arrive by 9 AM, and set up between then and 11 AM. No vendors will be allowed in after 11 AM.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Vendors selling and/or preparing food, must comply with Panhandle Health requirements. This is your responsibility!!! All food vendors are required to wear sanitary gloves, no exceptions. All food vendors are required to have a fire extinguisher in the booth at all times.


ENFORCEMENT & PERMITS: Historic Wallace Blues Festival decisions are final. Vendors must comply with all laws and regulations. Vendors are responsible for obtaining necessary permits and licenses, and these forms must be on display in the vendor's booth. Contact Donna at Panhandle Health, (208) 786-7474, for all required Health Department regulations.

LIABILITY: Vendors will certify that they will protect, defend, hold harmless and indemnify the Event, the Town, and the Historic Wallace Blues Festival Committee against any lost, damaged, or stolen property.

TRASH CANS: Will be provided for the general public. If your booth requires a trash can, you will need to provide your own. You will be responsible for keeping trash picked up within 20' of your booth area. If you use cooking oil, you will be required to provide a container for its proper disposal.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS: All food vendors must have a fire extinguisher in their booth at all times during the festival. Each vendor is required to bring their own tables, chairs, backboards, water source and a 100 ft. electrical cord.

PROHIBITIONS: The following items are NOT allowed to be sold at the Festival: drug paraphernalia, confederate flags, ethnically offensive items or T-shirts, and any other inappropriate or offensive items. And finally: "No Pets Allowed." Thank you.
